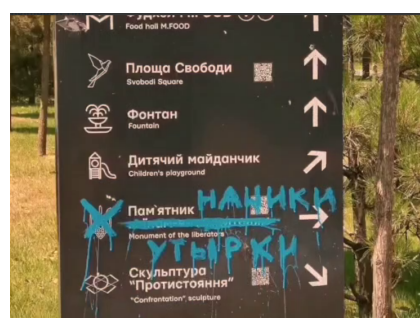
RUSSIAN PROPAGANDA

AS AN INSTRUMENT OF SUPPRESSION OF THE POPULATION

- In Mariupol, the invaders dismantled the Memorial to the deceased Ukrainian servicemen¹. The slabs on which the names of the Heroes were carved were demolished and thrown away along with construction rubble. The signpost was desecrated by vandals.

- In the occupied territories, the occupying authorities are conducting a propaganda campaign aimed at undermining the moral and psychological stability of the pro-Ukrainian population remaining in the city and disillusionment of residents in the Ukrainian authorities. The management of large enterprises in Melitopol was instructed to hold meetings and talks with staff, at which the following information should be broadcast: "Ukraine has already been divided. On the territory of the western oblasts, Polish zlotys were introduced, in most stores there are double price tags. There is nowhere to run from Russia. Ukraine is not what it used to be."

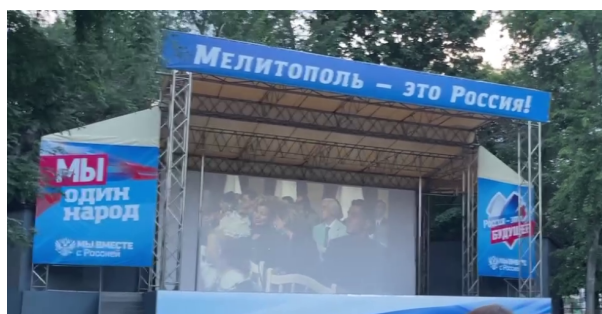
- The streets of Severodonetsk are equipped with mobile TVs broadcasting Russian news.

PREPARATIONS FOR PSEUDO-REFERENDUMS

ON THE ACCESSION OF THE OCCUPIED OBLASTS TO THE RUSSIAN FEDERATION

- In Melitopol, a “forum of the public movement 'We are together with Russia'” was held, at which the collaborator and the so-called head of the military-civilian administration of Zaporizhzhya oblast Yevhen Balytskyi said that he had signed an order to start preparations for a “referendum” on the annexation of the occupied territories to the Russian Federation. At the “forum” a children's choir performed the Soviet song “Where the Motherland Begins”.

- According to the Kherson OMA, before the fake referendum is held in the oblast, “vote buying” is taking place - an increasing number of institutions are opening, where everyone is promised financial assistance in the amount of 10 thousand rubles.

- According to the Security Service of Ukraine, the occupiers have developed a concept for preparing for a fake referendum and identified the main areas of work with reference to dates. It is planned to entrust the main role in its organization and holding to the pro-Kremlin organization "Volunteers for Russia". Under the supervision of the special services of the Russian Federation, its participants should disperse in oblast to simulate the support of the occupiers by local residents, as well as to create staged stories for Russian television. To this end, the "activists" are planning to organize more than 140 simultaneous pro-Russian pickets, of which about 30 are to be held in Kherson. The campaign meetings will be covered by the pro-Kremlin media and bloggers, who are already being massively moved to the region.

Representatives of the occupation administrations were instructed to create 20 election commissions under the leadership of local collaborators. To strengthen electoral support, it is planned to distribute food packages and starter packages for Russian mobile operators.

At the same time, according to the intercepted materials, the collaborators "report" to their Russian curators that Kherson residents do not accept the idea of "joining", they are actively resisting and expecting oblast to be liberated from the aggressor.

- According to the information of the Defence Intelligence of the Ministry of Defence of Ukraine (hereinafter - GUR MoD):

- In large settlements of the southern part of the Zaporizhzhya oblast, representatives of the occupying authorities are searching for collaborators who will create extras at "spontaneous actions" in support of the referendum. This, according to representatives of the occupation administrations, will help reduce the degree of dissatisfaction with the war and will create an appropriate TV picture for the citizens of the Russian Federation. In particular, the arrival in Melitopol of Russian specialists for conducting PR campaigns was noted. The working headquarters of these representatives was opened in the occupied premises of the Foxtrot store.
- A recruiting center is open and operating in Berdiansk for those wishing to cooperate with the occupation authorities/collaborators. Despite the serious "financial incentives", there are few who want to. In order to create a picture for the Kremlin TV channels, the invaders are forced to bring "activists" from the territory of the occupied Crimea.
- The importation of so-called "humanitarian cargo" from the territory of the Russian Federation continues. The conditions for receiving "humanitarian aid" or its monetary compensation are participation in "actions of support" of the occupation regime and the provision of personal passport data. To coordinate actions, a public movement "We are together with Russia" was created. Its task is to organize paid "mass actions in support of the referendum." Local residents with pro-Russian views and representatives of the United Russia party are appointed to oversee the distribution of "humanitarian aid" and conduct actions.

ELEMENTS OF TERROR

FROM THE SIDE OF OCCUPATION ADMINISTRATIONS IN OCCUPIED TERRITORIES

■ Forced issuing of passports continues in the temporarily occupied territories of Ukraine:

- Residents of Melitopol and its adjacent territories, whose lease agreement for land plot has expired, are obliged to conclude a new agreement on the basis of the received Russian passport and in accordance with Russian law. Those citizens whose lease agreements are still valid must conclude new ones using a similar procedure. If the term of the lease agreement has expired and the owner has not appeared, the person will be deprived of the right to own land plot.
- The so-called Minister of agrarian policy of Kherson oblast Oleksii Kovalov calls on farmers to register their activities and pay "taxes" under the legislation of the Russian Federation. Those who refuse will be deprived of the right to own land plots, and the owners of agribusiness will be expelled from oblast.
- In the village of Kamianske, Zaporizhzhya oblast, the occupation administration is taking measures to transfer the activities of local businesses to tax standards in accordance with the legislation of the Russian Federation. Representatives of business and the self-employed population received relevant letters. The main requirement for business activity is the presence of Russian citizenship.

- ### ■ On the stage of the Mariupol Chamber Philharmonic, Russian invaders are installing prison cells for Ukrainian captured soldiers, over whom a "military tribunal" is planned. The so-called head of the DPR, Denis Pushilin, on the air of one Russian propaganda channel, confirmed that preparations for the first show trial of "war criminals" were underway.

- **The pressure of the invaders is growing on the local population of the occupied territories:**
 - Upon arrival in Balakliia, Kharkiv oblast, a new battalion of Russian soldiers, in particular from among the former criminal prisoners mobilized in the Russian Federation, the aggressive attitude towards the local population increased sharply, the servicemen demonstrate cruelty and immoral behavior.
 - In Hola Prystan, Kherson oblast, the pressure of the local population at checkpoints is increasing.
 - In many settlements, the occupiers threaten to close and nationalize enterprises. It is planned to impose a monthly "tax" on each car of enterprises in the amount of RUB 5,000.

- **In Mariupol, the Russians use Ukrainian prisoners of war, in particular those who were previously fighting at Azovstal, to exhume the bodies of the dead.** Soldiers are forced at gunpoint to retrieve without any means of protection the bodies that have laid in the ground for several months.

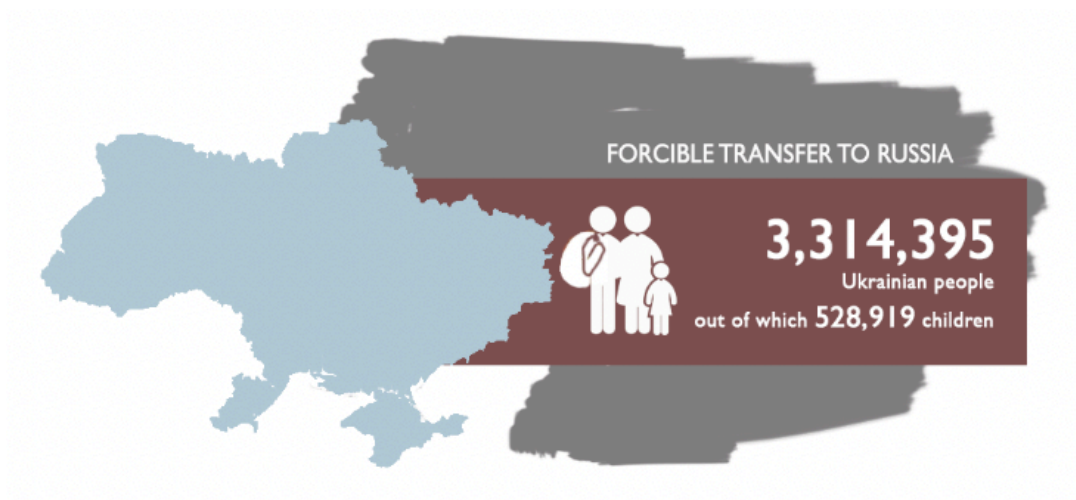

- **Employees of the captured Zaporizhzhya nuclear power plant told BBC journalists that they are the actual hostages of the Russians.** According to them, the invaders turned off the Internet, allowed only Russian sim cards to be used, and turned the educational building into a barracks. Meals for workers are provided in one single canteen, as they have set up their bases in the rest of them. Due to the fact that observation points are located on the roofs, the access there is prohibited. The Russian military freely moves around the station with weapons, the personnel are forced to work in fact at gunpoint. Respondents confirmed that the Russians use the station as a military base, spoke about the daily threat of kidnapping, as well as their fears about "radioactive contamination of the surrounding areas" and a nuclear catastrophe. Communication with journalists took place via texting.

- **On August 2, the invaders kidnapped the director of Havrylivska school in the Kalanchak community in Kherson oblast, Tetiana Tkachenko.** According to the first deputy head of Kherson Oblast Council, Yuri Sobolevskyi, there is tremendous pressure on school principals throughout the region, as the vast majority of teachers refuse to work with the occupiers and reorganize the work of educational institutions under the Russian program.

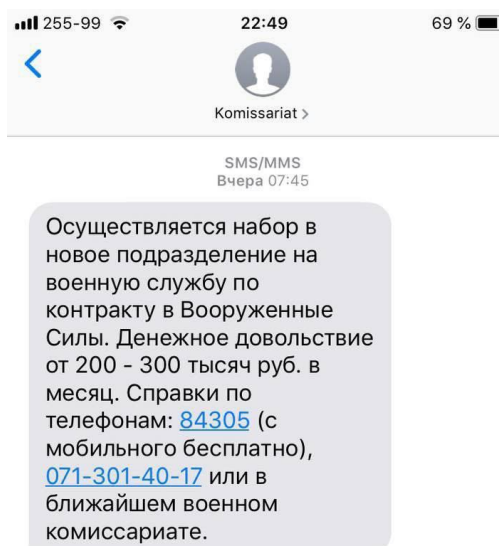

MOBILIZATION AT THE OCCUPIED TERRITORIES

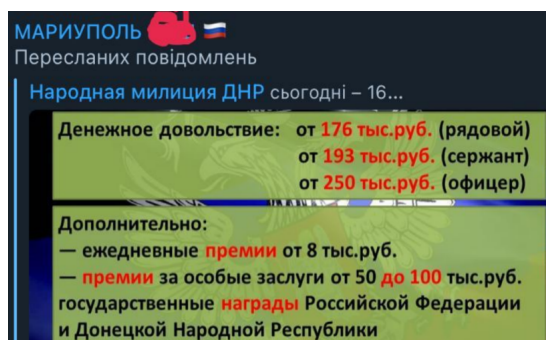

- Covert mobilization continues in Mariupol. In the Telegram channels controlled by the occupiers, advertisements for contract service in the ranks of the “People’s Militia of the DPR” are placed. As stated in the announcement, “volunteers that are in good health, moral and business qualities are invited to stand up for the Republic.” Also, the city is recruiting for the vacant positions of “inspector of the police patrol and checkpoint service.” According to the employees of the Mariupol city council, the occupation administration decided to announce the start of official mobilization immediately after the pseudo-referendum on joining the so-called DPR to the Russian Federation.

- In the settlements of Luhansk oblast, in order to replenish the mobilization reserve, the occupiers collect information from pensioners about men in exchange for food. According to the head of the Luhansk OMA Serhii Haidai, during their tours of high-rise buildings, they ingratiate themselves with the elderly, offering them small amounts of money or food in exchange for information about men of drafting age. They are leaving the military on duty near the closed entrances to wait for male residents to either leave or try to return home.

HUMANITARIAN SITUATION IN OCCUPIED SETTLEMENTS

- Melitopol Mayor Ivan Fedorov reports that more than a thousand cars are waiting in line at the checkpoint in the occupied Vasylivka to enter the territory controlled by the Ukrainian authorities. As is known, residents of Berdyansk, Vasylivka, Melitopol districts of the Zaporizhzhya oblast, as well as Kherson and Donetsk oblasts pass specifically through Vasylivka. Since August 1, the occupiers have tightened the rules for exit. Now one needs a special pass, which can be obtained at the commandant's office. According to the mayor, 10 people have already died while waiting in line.

- There is no centralized water supply in Lysychansk due to the destroyed water pipeline, and there is practically no clean water in the city. According to local residents, the streets are extremely dirty - there is a terrible smell from unburied bodies, broken sewers and garbage. People are forced to build toilets right in the yards of high-rise buildings.

- The so-called deputy of the People's Council of the LPR, Vitaly Kishkinov, said that mobile bathing stations began to operate in Severodonetsk, and can accommodate more than 100 people a day. Also at this point, residents will be able to charge mobile phones, flashlights and portable electrical devices. According to Kishkinov, the citizens of Severodonetsk will be able to "exercise their civil rights and communicate with the leadership of the administration, whose policy is aimed at restoring the city's infrastructure and improving the life of citizens."

- Ukrposhta took a decision to stop serving abonents in the territories occupied by the invaders. The company explained that the threat to the lives of employees has increased significantly and cases of robberies by the invaders have become more frequent. Previously, Ukrposhta continued to pay pensions, accept and transfer payments for utilities, and deliver food.

- A video appeared on the network of a huge queue to leave Enerhodar and nearby cities to the territory controlled by the Ukrainian authorities. Residents are leaving the oblast en masse against the backdrop of constant shelling of the area of the Zaporizhzhya nuclear power plant. Because of the checkpoints of the occupiers, who do not allow cars to pass, people are forced to stand in traffic jams for hours under the scorching sun.

- The head of the Severodonetsk City Military Administration Oleksandr Striuk reports that there is no electricity and water in the city, and the sewerage system does not work. Many shops have been destroyed, groceries are brought from other settlements and they are sorely lacking. To clean the streets, the occupiers form brigades, offering workers food products as wages. About 8 thousand people remain in the city.

- In Severodonetsk there are collapses of crumbling high-rise buildings. The corresponding video was published by the head of the Luhansk OMA Serhii Haidai. The emergency building on Partyzanska Street collapsed in the middle of the day, when people were walking nearby.

- Due to the lack of water supply in Severodonetsk, tanks with technical water have been installed on the streets of the city, two “hygienic centers” have been placed - shower tents, the services of which can be used after standing in a long queue.

- Advisor to the Mariupol mayor Petro Andriushchenko said that Mariupol remains unsafe for the civilian population. The occupiers carry out operational demining exclusively at points of their own interest - at factories and in the port. On the streets of the city, in courtyards and apartments, mines and the remains of shells remain in large numbers. Russian sappers do not go out for calls. People are forced to wait weeks for clearance.

- In the occupied settlements of the Izium district of Kharkiv oblast, in particular Izium and Balakliia, there are constant disruptions of water supply. Often there is no water for 3-4 days a week. In cities, problems are expected during the heating season. In Izium, boiler houses are destroyed, gas pipelines are broken, and electricity supply is not fully restored.

- Decree of the so-called State Defense Committee of the DPR determines the procedure for compensation for lost or damaged housing, as well as for lost necessities of life to persons affected by hostilities.

It is assumed that persons affected by the hostilities will be provided with compensation:

- for lost housing - monetary compensation or providing accommodation in multi-apartment housing buildings;
- for damaged housing, as well as for lost necessities of life - monetary compensation.

- The employees from Russia, seconded by Mosvodokanal JSC to the occupied Shchastia, Luhansk oblast, recorded a video message to the President of the Russian Federation with a request to help resolve the issue of wages. According to the workers who came to "restore the LPR", they work without an employment contract. Demands to conclude it on the terms stipulated at the time of hiring were not satisfied. "We did not even suspect that we could be deceived, given the public attention drawn to this problem [to the restoration of the so-called LPR]," the appeal reads.

■ According to GUR MoD:

- In Kherson, representatives of the occupation administration put forward requirements for ambulance workers to write statements of consent to work under the auspices of the "new government", which also implies their consent to receive wages in Russian rubles. In case of refusal, employees are provided with a temporary work permit with a warning about possible dismissal at any time.
- The invaders are trying to resume training at the Kherson Maritime Academy. The start of recruitment of cadets for the 2022-2023 academic year has been announced. A green flag with a "Z" mark is hung on the buildings of the academy.
- In Kherson oblast, measures are being taken to collect personal data of citizens. Currently, all utility workers and pensioners receiving the so-called humanitarian aid are required to fill questionnaires. Data is also collected from those who apply to the occupying authorities on any issues - registration of newborns, provision of medical care, etc. Also, everyone who has purchased starter packs of mobile operators in the Russian Federation receives SMS-messages with a proposal to provide personal data in exchange for 5 GB of Internet.

- In Rubizhne, the reburial of the residents of the city, who died from the shelling of the Russian army back in March-April, and were buried in residential courtyards, continues. According to the head of the Luhansk OMA, Serhii Haidai, the remains of 63 dead local residents were buried in early August.

SITUATION

IN CERTAIN AREAS OF DONETSK, LUHANSK OBLASTS AND CRIMEA

- Activists of the Zhovta Strichka movement are distributing Ukrainian symbols in Luhansk and Donetsk, tying yellow and blue-yellow ribbons, and posting leaflets against holding a pseudo-referendum on the annexation of the occupied territories to the Russian Federation.

- Soldiers of the so-called LPR recorded a video message in which they declare that they refuse to fight on the territory of the so-called DPR. According to them, they fulfilled their duty to "defend the Motherland", and the "head of the LPR" Leonid Pasechnik declared July 3, 2022 the Victory Day. The soldiers complain that by threats, blackmail, intimidation and deceit, authorities are trying to send them to the territory of the so-called DPR.

- According to the GUR MoD, a new wave of forced mobilization began on the territory of ORDLO on August 1 to recruit units of the mobilization reserve. They draft persons unfit for military service, and those who had a draft deferment.

On the streets of the city of Khrustalniy (formerly Krasnyi Luch) in Luhansk oblast, the number of patrols has increased, taking males to the military commissariat without explanation. In Luhansk, in 40 minutes, two buses of men were picked up at the market, most of which were porters. The raids on enterprises and commercial establishments employing men fit for military service continue.

At the same time, among the already drafted residents of ORDLO, dissatisfaction is brewing with the unfair attitude of the command of the occupying army towards the local personnel. In particular, information is being circulated that Russians are being given modern body armor and helmets, and to local servicemen - ammunition of the 1941-1945 model.

- Drafted residents of the so-called DPR recorded a video in which they demonstrated the military equipment they were provided with. Soldiers are given uniforms a few sizes larger, given tactical boots of mismatching sizes or not given at all, which is why some of draftees are forced to either buy it themselves or go to war in sneakers. - **Andrii Yusov, a representative of the GUR MoD, spoke about the peculiarities of the mobilization of residents of the so-called DPR and LPR.** According to him, the Russians treat the inhabitants of ORDLO as people of lower quality. While covert mobilization continues in the Russian Federation, where they try to motivate the signing of military contracts with money, stimulate payments or agitate for ideological purposes through propaganda channels, then on the territory of the so-called DPR and LPR men are simply taken from the streets.

In Luhansk, a meeting of representatives of the occupation administration with the business community was held, where it was brought to the attention that in order to make up for losses and restore the combat capability of units, it is necessary to mobilize another 8,000 men under the age of 60 in the near future. Businesses hide their skilled employees, without whom they cannot work, mothers hide their children and husbands.

From the very beginning, residents of ORDLO, even those with Russian passports, were used as cannon fodder for reconnaissance in force. Despite their unsatisfactory training and poor ammunition, they were thrown into the most difficult sectors of the front.

- **Russian soldiers who refuse to fight in Ukraine are forcibly kept in detention centers on the territory of the so-called LPR.** Their command does not accept the submitted reports and refuses to send them to the points of permanent deployment. It is known that in Bryansk alone up to 200 people can be held in the center for those who refuse to serve in the military. The appeal of members of the Human Rights Council to the Chief Military Prosecutor Office of the Russian Federation states that Russian servicemen can be held by force in at least four more occupied cities of Ukraine.

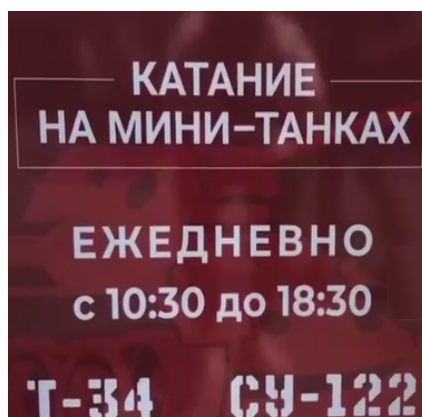
To convince the military to return to the front, different methods are used. First of all, they are threatened with criminal proceedings and that they will be sent to the front line. Because of the pressure, some soldiers withdraw their reports and return to combat missions.

Russian human rights activists believe that the detention of the military in prisons of the so-called LPR and attempts to prevent them from leaving the war zone are connected with the growing number of refusals to fight in Ukraine.

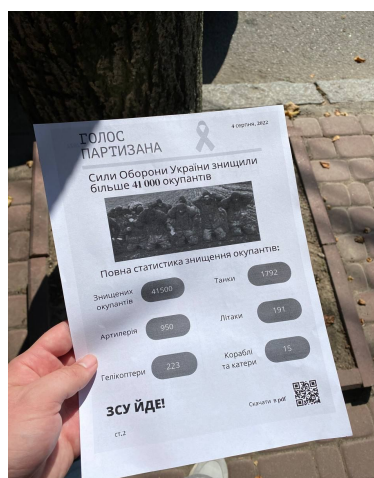
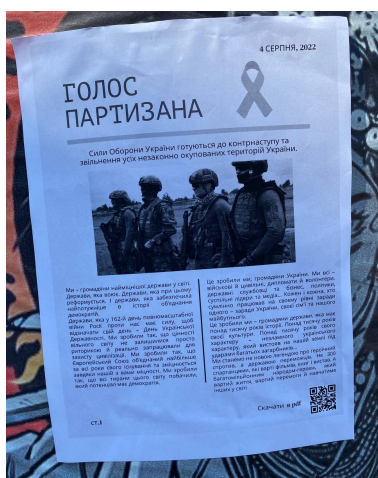
- In Kherson, leaflets are being distributed with an algorithm for the actions of the civilian population during the liberation of the city from Russian invaders. In the booklets, citizens are advised to find shelters, charge gadgets, stock up on food and medicines.

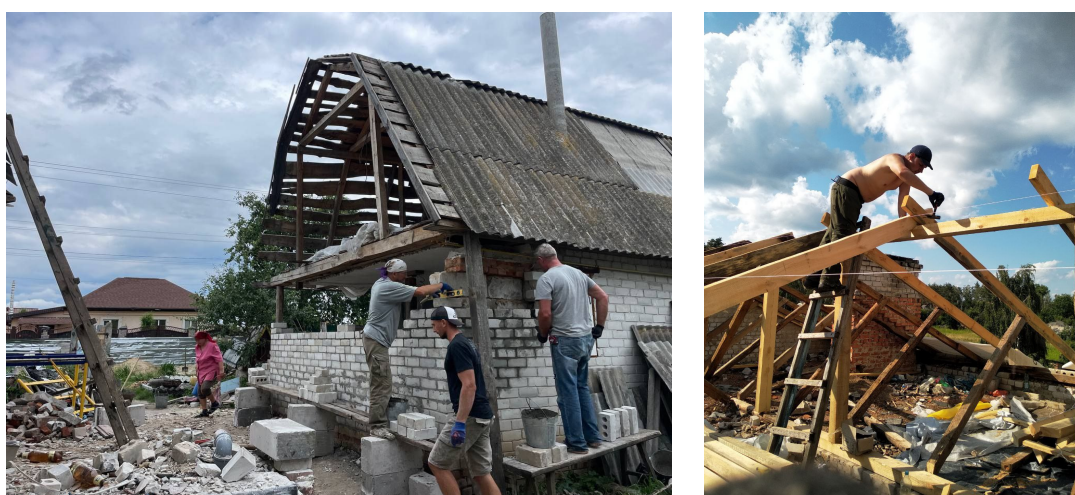
