The situation in the Ukrainian territories temporarily controlled by the Russian army

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ELEMENTS OF TERROR

FROM THE SIDE OF THE RUSSIAN ARMY AND OCCUPATION ADMINISTRATIONS

■ In the village of Kozacha Lopan in Kharkiv oblast, which was de-occupied on 11 September, journalists from Radio Svoboda spoke to Oleh Dyhalo, a member of the Derhachiv city council who had spent 10 days in Russian captivity.

His nephew and son, who has haemophilia, a disease in which the blood clotting process is impaired, were forcibly held with him. All three were beaten by the Russian military. According to Oleh, when he asked them not to hit his son, the occupiers started hitting him even harder. A man was threatened with the gang rape of his 17-year-old daughter in front of him, administered electric shocks and hung by his arms.

Melitopol mayor Ivan Fedorov spoke about a new wave of terror by the Russian occupiers against civilians.

According to him, filtration activities are taking place in some parts of the city. Melitopol has been blocked for entry and exit. Several checkpoints have been placed on the central streets, where all vehicles and passengers are searched.

■ In the liberated settlements of Kharkiv oblast, police officers found entire houses turned by the Russian occupants into warehouses with looted property, which they did not have time to send home because of the rapid counterattack by the Ukrainian Armed Forces.

Among the items found were furniture, household appliances such as washing machines, TV sets, microwave ovens, kitchen utensils, paintings, and bed linen. Law enforcement authorities are searching for the owners of the stolen items.

 According to the Ukrainian Armed Forces' General Staff, the Russians plan to start mobilizing locals in the temporarily occupied territory of Zaporizhzhia oblast in order to replenish current losses.

In particular, in Melitopol, summonses were issued to men of military age demanding them to come to the military commissariat as soon as possible

During the occupation of the Makiivka village in Luhansk oblast, Russian servicemen stole a truck, power tools, a pumping station, household appliances, clothes, shoes, two hunting rifles, poultry, and livestock from local residents.

A woman behind the scenes said that the child had been taken from dysfunctional parents and offered to adopt him

According to Andriushchenko, a not insignificant number of children in Mariupol and Mariupol district remain without custody due to the arrest of their parents due to their failure to undergo filtration.

Such men and women are declared "dysfunctional parents," taken to an unknown destination, their children taken away and placed with Russian foster families with the help of Maria Lvova-Belova, the Children's Rights Commissioner for the President of Russia.

Petro Andriushchenko asked journalists to publicize the case.

ZAPORIZHZHIA NUCLEAR POWER PLANT

■ The IAEA Director General Raphael Grossi said he hoped to reach an agreement with Russia and Ukraine by the end of the year to establish a protection zone at the Zaporizhzhia NPP.

■ Energoatom reports that several Grad multiple rocket launchers have been brought into the territory of the seized Zaporizhzhia nuclear power plant.

The invaders placed this weapon near power unit No.6, directly next to the territory of the station dry spent fuel storage facility.

The most likely provocation being prepared is an attack on the opposite bank of the Dnipro River, in particular the cities of Nikopol and Marhanets, firing these Grad systems directly from the ZNPP site, using the "cover" of power units and spent fuel storage facility.

On December 8, Russian invaders broke into the office of social programs of the Zaporizhzhia NPP and, in the presence of other workers, severely beat the head of the department, Oleksii Trubenkov, and his deputy, Yurii Androsov.

After beating them, the occupiers took them out of the premises and took them in an unknown direction.

In addition, the Russian military detained and "threw into the basement" the shift chief of the nuclear power plant Konstiantyn Beiner – he is a licensed person directly responsible for nuclear and radiation safety at the facility.

Energoatom believes that with such actions the occupiers are trying to break the station's pro-Ukrainian staff and increase the number of transfers of employees to the fake Operational Organization of the Zaporizhzhia NPP, which is subordinate to *Rosatom*.

 According to the Ukrainian Defence Ministry's Main Directorate of Intelligence, representatives of Rosatom are embezzling money allocated to run the Zaporizhzhia nuclear power plant.

To this end, they issue fictitious financial documents (corporate cards) in the name of nuclear power plant employees who have Ukrainian citizenship. No real financial statements are produced or filed.

At the moment, about 500 Russian soldiers remain on the territory of Zaporizhzhia NPP, 200 of whom are the so-called "Kadyrovites" from the Akhmat battalion. Their main task is to intimidate the personnel and persuade them to cooperate with the occupiers.

HUMANITARIAN **SITUATION**

IN OCCUPIED SETTLEMENTS

Photos of thermometers showing sub-zero or near-zero temperatures in Mariupol flats are spreading online.

Residents of the city continue to suffer in unheated rooms with tarp-covered windows. Instead of replacing them, utility workers board up the windows with plywood and cardboard. Freezing water causes radiators to burst. Mariupol residents are forced to set up makeshift stoves right in their flats. The cold aggravates chronic diseases in elderly people. The city has turned off heating in houses and schools that have managed to connect to mobile boilers due to a lack of diesel fuel. The occupation authorities have not given a timetable for restarting it.

According to Oleksandr Striuk, Head of Sievierodonetsk Civil-Military Administration, the city's residents are in a very difficult situation.

There is no heating, the sewage system is completely destroyed, water is supplied sporadically and only to some buildings, and the electricity supply is partial. In December, work was intensified to supply electricity to the surviving buildings/entrances/flats.

■ In Sievierodonetsk, another list of empty flats planned to be broken into to house occupiers and collaborators, has been made public.

The announcement warns the owners to report to the administration and give their consent for unknown people to live there for a period of three years. At the same time, according to the Head of the Luhansk Regional Military Administration, Serhii Haidai, around 90% of the city's population have left for safer regions of Ukraine.

■ In Kherson oblast, a ban on crossing the Dnipro River in the Richkovyi vokzal section was lifted from 3 to 5 December to allow people in a country village on the left bank of the occupied Dnipro River to evacuate to Kherson in their own swimmers.

The evacuation of citizens was carried out during daylight hours. During the evacuation, it is necessary to have with you documents certifying your identity and confirming your citizenship of Ukraine.

■ In Prymorsk, Zaporizhzhia oblast, notices were posted notifying owners of movable and immovable property to contact the occupation administration with documents, otherwise the property would be considered ownerless and confiscated.

The lists of properties are constantly updated on the website of the so-called "administration." The list includes real estate belonging to Ukrainian citizens, vehicles, as well as communal and state property.

The occupants collect information on empty flats in the cities of Zaporizhzhia oblast through the heads of housing cooperatives.

■ Entrepreneurs in the occupied territories of Luhansk oblast must register with the unified state register of the Russian Federation with an updated package of Russian documents during December.

Otherwise, they will not be able to benefit from support measures for small and mediumsized businesses.

■ According to the Center for National Resistance, the Russians are urging locals on the occupied left bank of Kherson oblast to leave the region.

In particular, mass "evacuation" events took place in Oleshky and Nova Kakhovka. The occupants are taking their loot with them, including special and medical equipment. In fact, the occupiers are carrying out a programme to deport the Ukrainian population and resettle them in Russia.

PROPAGANDA AND FORCED RUSSIFICATION

■ The so-called "head of the DPR" Denys Pushylin opened a "Hero's Desk" at School No 2 in Manhush, Mariupol district, which bears the name of his predecessor, Oleksandr Zakharchenko, who was killed in a bomb attack in 2018.

As part of this propaganda campaign initiated by the United Russia party, "the best students of the school" will have the right to study at such a desk.

■ Law enforcers found and seized about 300 Russian textbooks for students of grades 1-9 in the lyceum in Khotimlya village, Kharkiv oblast, which had been brought to the school during the occupation of Kharkiv oblast.

In addition, three certificates of incomplete general secondary education along with annexes were found, signed by the so-called "head of military-civil administration of Kharkiv oblast."

IN CERTAIN AREA OF DONETSK, I UHANSK OBLASTS AND CRIMFA

■ In Makiivka, Donetsk oblast, bottled water is dispensed in the absence of a full centralized water supply.

To receive water, a passport with residence registration or a birth certificate is required if a child comes for water. Men are also checked if they have a note on registration with the military enlistment office. There have been cases of men being handed summonses in the water queue.


