ELEMENTS OF TERROR

FROM THE SIDE OF THE RUSSIAN ARMY AND OCCUPATION ADMINISTRATIONS

■ The temporarily occupied part of the Zaporizhia oblast is turning into a closed military base. According to Melitopol mayor Ivan Fedorov, the number of Russian soldiers, mobilized and mercenaries is increasing daily in the city, with the so-called Kadyrovtsy sent to control the discipline.

Out of fear of the resistance forces, the Russians are redeploying troops, organizing training evacuations and increasing pressure on civilians in an attempt to find members of the resistance movement.

Some 500 Rosgvardiya troops have arrived in Berdiansk to strengthen administrative and police operations.

■ The occupiers demolish a historic building in Mariupol, which was one of its symbols — the studio of the outstanding artist Viktor Arnautov.

The building is known to locals as the "House with a Clock." Before the full-scale invasion of the Russian Federation, the city authorities restored the building and installed a new clock. During the fighting, the historic building was destroyed.

 According to the AFU General Staff, the Russian occupiers have imposed a 24-hour curfew in Hornostaivka, Kherson oblast, from 25 December 2022 to 3 January 2023.

For almost 10 days, locals are forbidden to leave their flats and move around the settlement. In Vasylivka, Zaporizhzhia oblast, a curfew was introduced from 28 December 2022 to 4 January 2023. Emergency workers are issued with special passes.

 Russian invaders have tightened administrative and police measures in the settlement of Tokmak in Zaporizhzhia oblast.

The servicemen, together with local collaborators, are hunting down patriotically-minded Ukrainian citizens, checking personal laptops and phones, and searching homes.

■ The Russian occupiers continue to use educational institutions on temporarily occupied territory to shield their units.

For example, according to the General Staff of the Ukrainian Armed Forces, the occupiers have stationed personnel in schools in some settlements of Zaporizhzhia oblast's Vasylivskyi district. At the same time, the educational process continues, children attend the schools.

As part of the so-called evacuation from settlements on the left bank of the Kherson oblast, the Russian occupiers have taken the abducted patients of the mental health facilities of the cities of Nova Kakhovka and Oleshky, to the village of Strilkove on the Arabat Spit; people are being held in captured Geologist recreation centre.

Most of the staff have been brought from Russia, however, there are also locals who agreed to take care of the patients.

The occupiers deprive residents of the temporarily occupied territories of the Zaporizhia oblast of the opportunity to receive high-quality medical care.

The civilian hospitals have restricted admission of patients due to the large number of wounded Russian servicemen. Unimpeded travel to Zaporizhzhia, where the residents were going, in particular, to get treatment, is no longer possible.

At present, the nearest hospitals with qualified care are in Crimea. However, there is little access for civilians from the other occupied territories. Hospitals in Crimea do not accept prescriptions issued by doctors in the occupied part of Zaporizhzhia oblast; assistance is provided only with Russian medical insurance, which can only be obtained using a Russian passport.

According to an advisor to Mariupol mayor Petro Andriushchenko, in Manhush, Mariupol district, all police sergeants who betrayed their oath to Ukraine were sent to the front line near Bakhmut after completing a week-long military training course at a local training ground.

■ Animals were stolen from the Nova Kakhovka zoo in Kherson oblast and transported to the Taigan lion park in occupied Crimea, where previously stolen animals from Kherson had been brought.

■ Demolition of the Drama Theatre in Mariupol, where Russian bombs were dropped on 16 March, continues.

The attack killed hundreds of city residents who had been using the theatre building as a shelter. According to Petro Andriushchenko, advisor to Mariupol city mayor, the occupiers demolished the rear and central part of the theatre, while leaving the front as "the basis for reconstruction." Thus, it was those parts of the building which were evidence of a war crime committed by the Russian army that were dismantled.

IN OCCUPIED SETTLEMENTS

According to a Russian government decree, the regional subsistence level coefficient is set at 78% of the federal one in the temporarily occupied territory of Luhansk oblast next year.

■ The local department of the military enlistment office in Markivka, Luhansk oblast, published an announcement about the recruitment of volunteers for military service under a contract in the so-called "people's militia of the LPR."

Among the promises were a social package and a bonus two extra years of experience counted for each year of actual service.

According to the adviser of the Mariupol Petro Andriushchenko, the city is suffering from a rodent infestation.

Due to the lack of deratization and preventive measures against rats and mice, and due to the migration season from the fields, almost every multi-storey building faces rodent problems.

■ The Mariupol city council has in its possession documents from the education department of the city's occupation administration, according to which, 11022 school-age children were living in Mariupol as of December 2022.

According to Petro Andriushchenko, adviser to Mariupol mayor, this figure corresponds to the estimated total number of population in the city up to 120 thousand people.

Residents of the occupied Sievierodonetsk report that under the guise of repair work,
Russians break into their flats — both empty and inhabited.

One case describes how a person who remained under occupation went on business in the morning and after lunch found a cut-out door.

Radiators are cut along with pipes under the ceiling; they promise to install modern ones by the end of February. Along with the elements of the heating system, sometimes completely new, people's personal belongings disappear.

■ The Head of the Luhansk Regional Military Administration, Serhii Haidai, believes that the occupation authorities are increasingly leading people to believe that no one will rebuild their destroyed housing in the so-called Luhansk People's Republic.

The manoeuvrable fund is already being formed even in Sorokino (formerly Krasnodon), which was captured eight years ago, and the settlements of the district. The other day, the addresses of the flats that could be included in the manoeuvring housing fund were made public. The owners must report within 10 calendar days from the date of publication of this notification in order to agree or refuse to let unauthorized people move in for a period of three years.

Previously, the formation of such housing fund was reported in Sievierodonetsk, Lysychansk, Khrustalnyi, Stanytsia Luhanska community.

■ Coal production in the occupied territories of Luhansk and Donetsk oblasts fell by 42% in 2022.

According to Serhii Haidai, Head of the Luhansk Regional Military Administration, the occupiers have no plans to resume production because of such low figures and have set a task to work out the process of closing the mines.

The biggest problem for the coal industry, apart from the Russian occupation, is the forced mobilization of miners into the Russian army, as mines were already, on average, staffed by less than 50%. Women and pensioners predominate among the remaining workers.

Average consumer grocery prices in Luhansk oblast communities under occupation are significantly higher than in Ukrainian government-controlled territory.

Some food items cost more than twice as much. In particular, potatoes, beets, and poultry (chicken, whole). White cabbage is more expensive by 99.01%, rye-wheat bread — by 88.24%, pork — by 77.12%, sour cream — by 60.01%, white bread loaf — by 57.46%, sugar — by 49.72%, sunflower oil — by 47.41%, beef — by 44.86%.

■ The occupation administration in Luhansk oblast subordinated the settlements destroyed by the Russians in Popasna district to the city of Pervomaisk, effectively liquidating the district. It was decided to "temporarily" resettle the population in communal institutions of the so-called LPR. Another 22 residents were sent to a new place of settlement the other day.

According to the Center for National Resistance, the occupiers in the temporarily occupied territories are trying to identify children studying in Ukrainian online schools.

In particular, in Berdiansk, teachers checked phones for special applications. Respective conversations are being held with the children to find out the information. When the fact of Ukrainian online education is detected, parents are summoned for preventive conversations.

■ The propaganda media in Russia and the so-called DPR present Mariupol solely in terms of successful reconstruction of the city.

Mariupol was visited the other day by Irek Faizullin, the Minister of Construction, Housing, and Utilities of the Russian Federation. Together with the so-called head of the DPR, Denys Pushylin, he visited the construction of multi-storey buildings and a renovated school, handed over five keys for new flats. At the same time, most residents continue to live in dilapidated buildings, freezing in unheated flats, dependent on free lunches.

■ In occupied Mariupol, where tens of thousands of people have been sent for forced filtration, hundreds of whom have been imprisoned and tortured, a public reception centre of the so-called DPR Commissioner for Human Rights has been opened.

■ The Russian president has approved the procedure for applying for a Russian passport for residents of the so-called Donetsk and Luhansk People's Pepublics, Kherson and Zaporizhzhia oblasts who were registered in these territories before 30 September 2022.

The document also contains a provision on recognizing a child under 14 years of age as a Russian citizen. Additionally, the decree approves the procedure for submitting and recording applications for renunciation of Ukrainian citizenship. The document entered into force on the day of its official publication — 26 December 2022.

During the year, registration is free of charge and without compulsory insurance. A driving licence can be exchanged for a Russian driving licence without a driving test and without a medical examination.














Due to significant losses, the occupiers continue to convert civilian hospitals into military hospitals.

The Luhansk Regional Clinical Hospital, the Luhansk City Multidisciplinary Hospital No. 15 and the Railway Hospital have been given for the use of the Russian occupying forces. The local population is refused service and suggested that they seek treatment in other medical

Reportedly, more than 1,000 wounded invaders are currently in one of the hospitals alone. There are not enough medical staff and surgeons' assistants for all of them. Medical institutions do not have enough medication or even beds and bed linen for so many patients.


