

PROPAGANDA AND FORCED RUSSIFICATION

IN THE OCCUPIED TERRITORIES

■ The stele at the entrance to Mariupol was repainted in the colors of the Russian flag, and the Ukrainian letter "i" in the name of the city was changed to the Russian "i".

■ Emergency services on the territory of the Zaporizhzhya oblast were assigned Russian telephone numbers with the code "+7". Ambulance, police, emergency service of PJSC Melitopolgaz received new numbers. Calls from sim-cards of Ukrainian operators are charged as calls abroad

■ In Kherson and Melitopol, the first Russian passports were issued under a simplified procedure for obtaining Russian citizenship.

Sale of sim-cards of Russian mobile operators continues in Kherson. Currently, there is a significant shortage of cards in the mobile services market. When selling sim cards, sellers take pictures of the first and second pages of the passport of citizens of Ukraine. In order to establish full control over telecommunications services, the invaders are completing the connection of the networks of the occupied part of the Kherson oblast and Russia (through Crimea). Access to some Ukrainian websites and online banking services has been blocked. Telecommunication equipment of Ukrainian operators Kyivstar and Vodafone is configured to work through the Russian Federation.

On June 1, on Children's Day, an open lesson of the Russian language was held at school No. 53 in Mariupol, a gift was presented from the governor of St. Petersburg in the form of textbooks and copybooks in Russian. At the street festival, the children were given the "ABC of Donbass".

■ In honor of the Day of Russia, on June 12, "festive events" were held in the occupied cities: in Mariupol, a Russian flag of 2.4 thousand m2 was unfurled on the Square of the Wariors-Liberators, in Kherson a solemn meeting was organized, which was attended by about 30-40 spectators, a concert was held in the city park of Melitopol. Billboards with congratulations on the Day of Russia were installed in Berdyansk the day before.

■ Journalist from the so-called DPR Alena Morozova conducts tours of the building of the Mariupol Drama Theater destroyed by the Russian army, during which she talks about the "crimes of the Ukrainian authorities" and the "meanness of the Armed Forces of Ukraine" who allegedly set up combat positions in the theater building.

In the Kherson oblast, Russian invaders are conducting a "sociological survey". People receive calls asking them to answer a number of manipulative questions about their attitude to the Russian Federation, the war, the occupation, and Putin personally.

Main questions:

- How do you assess the situation in your oblast?
- How do you assess the situation in Kherson?
- What needs to be done by "local authorities" to improve living conditions?
- How do you feel about the "special military operation" in Ukraine?
- How do you feel about Vladimir Putin?
- How do you feel about the Russian army?
- In your opinion, should Kherson be part of Russia or follow the path of the so-called L/DPR or join the "Republic of Crimea"?
- Are there any relatives in Ukraine and Russia?
- What should the Ukrainian authorities do: forget about the oblast, leave it alone, write off debts?
- What should Russia do for the oblast: improve education, pensions, roads, etc.?

According to the Defence Intelligence of the Ministry of Defence of Ukraine (hereinafter - GUR), the majority of Kherson residents refuse to answer questions. Those who agree under pressure cannot give a sincere answer due to security concerns.

The results of the pseudo-survey, which do not have any legitimacy, can later be issued by the occupying authorities as an illustration of the loyalty of the local population to the invaders. The results of the "social study", where the Ukrainians allegedly "expressed support for the occupation regime," may become the basis for the accession of the Kherson oblast to the Russian Federation, even if it is impossible to hold a referendum.

- In Mariupol, in order to strengthen anti-Ukrainian sentiment and form public opinion about the refusal to evacuate to Ukraine, fake narratives are being spread that:
 - all people remaining in the city are criminals and are subject to arrest when crossing checkpoints in Ukraine;
 - all pensions and social payments received or stored on bank cards of Mariupol residents will be directed to the Armed Forces of Ukraine, if they are not withdrawn from the account in the near future;
 - all men are immediately mobilized into the Ukrainian army when crossing checkpoints in Ukraine

The Mariupol City Council draws attention to the absolute falsity of these statements and asks to actively convey truthful information to the residents of the city.

According to the Defence Intelligence of the Ministry of Defence of Ukraine, the occupying administration of Kherson held a meeting of school principals in the oblast, at which a demand was made to start the educational process in accordance with Russian educational programs from September 1. Of the approximately 60 principals present, only two accepted the offer. Accordingly, they were instructed to hold meetings of their teaching staff and force their subordinates to re-register their employment in accordance with Russian law by concluding agreements with the occupation administration.

A similar meeting was held with employees of the Kherson Directorate of Railway Transportation Ukrzaliznytsya. Representatives of the occupation administration said that the money will be paid only to workers who will cooperate. In this case, the amount of payments will be half the current salaries.

■ A new batch of textbooks on the subjects "Russian language", "Literary reading" in the amount of 10 thousand copies, workbooks and copybooks was brought to Mariupol from Russia.

ATROCITIES OF THE RUSSIAN ARMY

■ The court of the so called DPR sentenced three foreigners - Britons Sean Pinner and Aiden Eslin, as well as Moroccan citizen Saadoun Brahima - to death, accusing them of "mercenarism" and "committing actions aimed at seizing power and overthrowing the" constitutional structure "of the DPR group". It is worth noting that foreigners are active servicemen of the Armed Forces of Ukraine, and in fact are prisoners of war.

In the Mariupol region, the invaders are arresting Ukrainian volunteers and officials who refused to cooperate with collaborators and the occupying authorities. Known facts that the court of the so called DPR sentenced the head of one of the Azov settlements to 10 years in prison. A Ukrainian judge, who has considered several high-profile cases regarding separatism, is awaiting the verdict of the pseudo-republic. There is information about the use of torture against her.

Also in the prison in Yelenivka are several dozen volunteers who, in March-April 2022, helped evacuate residents of Mariupol and tried to deliver food and water to the blocked city.

■ The Russian military, with the assistance of local collaborators, captured Kherson State University and kidnapped the vice-rector of the educational institution Maksym Vinnyk. Vinnyk's colleagues note that he has a disability and needs constant medical care. The rector of KSU Oleksandr Spivakovskyi in his video message said that the university's control center was temporarily moved to Ivano-Frankivsk back in April, so the seizure of the university will not affect the educational process in any way.


FILTRATION CAMPS AND DEPORTATION

OF CITIZENS OF UKRAINE AS ELEMENTS OF TERROR BY THE RUSSIAN FEDERATION

■ In previous issues of the bulletin, the work of the filtration prison was described that is situated in former Yenakiyevo strict regime colony No. 52 in Olenivka, Donetsk oblast. Employees of the Mariupol City Council received information about the functioning of the second such prison, which operates in the village of Molodizhne on the basis of the former Volnovakha correctional colony No. 120. "Unreliable" persons are kept here until a verdict is passed or they undergo filtration. In this prison there are more than 20 volunteers who helped residents of Mariupol during the evacuation period. Almost all of these volunteers had IDs of the Red Cross of Ukraine.

Subscribers of the mobile operator Phoenix of the so-called DPR in Mariupol receive texts from the so-called Ministry of Justice of the DPR with a call to get a job in correctional colonies, including those reopened, which in fact are filtration prisons. The filling of former places of punishment with "prisoners" occurs due to the strengthening of filtration measures.



According to Mikhail Mizintsev, head of the National Defense Control Center of the Russian Federation, who heads the Russian interdepartmental coordination headquarters for humanitarian response in Ukraine, 1,690,814 Ukrainians have been taken to Russia since the beginning of the war, of which 273,359 are children.

- The practice of passing filtration inside Mariupol has been discontinued. All those who did not pass it must go by organized buses to the filtration camps in the villages Nikolske or Bezimene and in a special accommodation point, expect filtration for several days with the risk of being deported to Russia.
 - One can go through the filtration on their own by driving to the city of Dokuchaevsk, Donetsk oblast, but it takes a week or longer to get a pass to move in the occupational commandant's office of Mariupol.

HUMANITARIAN SITUATION

IN THE OCCUPIED TERRITORIES

■ In the temporarily occupied territories, there are significant problems with access to medicines. According to the Minister of Health of Ukraine Viktor Lyashko, there are no humanitarian corridors for the delivery of medicines to healthcare facilities. According to the chief doctors of hospitals in the uncontrolled territories, there are problems even with saline solutions. In some quantities, there are drugs previously imported with a large supply for the treatment of cancer patients and patients on dialysis.

- In the occupied territories of the Kherson oblast, there is no mobile connection and partly the Internet. According to the Kherson City Council, communication was restored only in some settlements, and repair work continues.
 - At the same time, due to the lack of communication and the Internet, ATMs do not work in Kherson. One can withdraw cash only in cafes, shops and in the market with 7% fee.

In Nova Kakhovka and Beryslav, Kherson oblast, the occupiers are forcing the population to hand over 70% of the harvest to buyers from Crimea. Purchase prices are sometimes around 10% of the retail price. At the same time, there is a ban on the export of crops to territories controlled by Ukraine. There are cases when farmers distribute strawberries and cherries to the population for free.

■ In Vasylivka, Zaporizhzhya oblast, right at the Russian checkpoint, truck drivers are forced to throw away tons of vegetables that were brought for sale in Zaporizhzhya. The Russian military is blocking the road and not letting farmers with their crops through, as well as blocking the humanitarian corridor in this direction.

■ The head of the occupation administration of the Zaporizhzhya oblast, Yevhen Balytskyi, signed a decree on the "nationalization of property belonging to Ukraine." The occupiers plan to transfer land plots, natural resources, objects of strategic sectors of the economy into the ownership of the oblast.

According to the Defence Intelligence of the Ministry of Defence of Ukraine, due to the mass refusal of teachers to conduct the educational process according to the Russian program, the occupiers in Melitopol hire people without pedagogical education to the positions of teachers. An increase in the number of teachers seconded from the Russian Federation and the occupied Crimea was also noted. Local teachers who refuse to cooperate with the occupiers are faced with domestic problems and threatened with reprisals.

EVERYDAY CHALLENGES

FOR MARIUPOL RESIDENTS

■ The city began to issue pensions in Russian rubles, which amounts UAH 2,600. According to the occupation administration, about 47,000 pensioners have registered. According to Petro Andryushchenko, adviser to the Mariupol mayor, about 10,000 residents of the city did not submit documents in protest against the occupation.

■ To get drinking water, city residents must sign up in advance (at least two days in advance). The reason for the reduced supply is a drop in the water level in natural sources.

From June 1, humanitarian aid is issued exclusively to people of retirement age. The rest of the residents can get it by taking part in public works. Young people are forced to sign up for "teams" and help mobile patrols, including in filtration activities. For refusal, they threaten with mobilization into the army of the so-called DPR.

To receive humanitarian aid, one must also sign up for a queue that lasts 2-3 days. On the day of its receipt, it is necessary to stand in a "live" queue, being in the heat for several hours.

In the city, "dealers" have become more active, ready to take cars out of the city for money.

■ There is an acute shortage of doctors - not only specialty doctors, but therapists in general. When Mariupol residents apply to medical institutions, they are offered to go to Donetsk on their own. At the moment, in Mariupol hospital No. 3, which serves the Central and Prymorskyi districts, where about 70,000 residents live, there are five doctors.

■ Due to the lack of an organized procedure for garbage collection, spontaneous dumps are observed in many courtyards of the city. Given the high air temperature, the lack of an established water supply, this problem can lead to the spread of infectious diseases.






■ In Mariupol, the occupiers provide a certificate of death and the right to be buried in a separate grave in a coffin only upon death from natural causes. In case of death of a person under shelling or death from injuries received, a certificate is not issued. A person is buried namelessly exclusively in a mass grave. After burial, relatives may be issued a certificate of "missing".


■ The difficulties of life in Mariupol are covered in city advertisements - the search for missing relatives, the exchange of gasoline for the opportunity to charge the phone, the sale of places for filtering in Starobesheve.

Near the former shopping center there is a storage facility for the bodies of the dead Mariupol residents. After the exhumation of the dead from graves hastily made under shelling, collecting the bodies during the removal of rubble, they are delivered for subsequent reburial to the so-called "morgue", where they lie directly on the asphalt in the open air at an air temperature of +25 °C. According to witnesses, there is a sharp smell of decomposing bodies everywhere.

COLLABORATIONISM

The "head of administration" of the Chornobaivska territorial community, Yuriy Turuliv, appointed by the occupiers, was informed by the Darnytsia District Prosecutor Office of Kyiv about suspicion of collaborative activities. The suspect voluntarily agreed to occupy a position related to the performance of organizational, administrative and economic functions in illegal authorities established in the temporarily occupied territory. Prior to his appointment, the "head of administration" worked as the head of the local bus station.

■ In Mariupol, about 90 employees of the National Police in the Donetsk oblast transferred to the service in the so-called DPR. An advisor to the mayor of Mariupol, Petro Andryushchenko, published a video about it.

■ Olha Botman, a former employee of the Mariupol City Council, voluntarily agreed to cooperate with the occupiers and was appointed to the post of Deputy "head of administration" of Mariupol for legal issues.

In Kupyansk, a meeting of representatives of all the occupied districts of the Kharkiv oblast was held, at which a "temporary civil administration of the Kharkiv oblast" was created. Vitalii Hanchev, a former policeman, became its "head"; in 2014 he changed his oath and entered the service of the police of the so-called LPR.

■ The State Bureau of Investigation opened a criminal case against Svyatohirsk mayor Volodymyr Bandura on suspicion of treason. According to investigators, Bandura was engaged in the dissemination of Russian narratives and discrediting the Armed Forces of Ukraine, accusing the Ukrainian military of killing priests and monks and setting fire to the skete on the territory of the Svyatohirsk Lavra. At the same time, earlier the mayor of Svyatohirsk publicly demonstrated a pro-Ukrainian position, in particular, on his Facebook page, he used the wording "Russian occupiers", "Russian aggressor", spoke about the crimes of the invaders, urged residents to evacuate. Some media speculate that perhaps Bandura is being held captive.

The people's deputy, elected in the majority district in the Kherson oblast from the Servant of the People party, Oleksii Kovalov, agreed to cooperate with the Russian occupiers. He attended a meeting of Sergei Kiriyenko, First Deputy Head of the Presidential Administration of the Russian Federation, "with the farmers of the Kherson oblast" and spoke in favor of closer integration with Russia. In May, the people's deputy was expelled from the Servant of the People party.

THE SITUATION

IN CERTAIN AREAS OF DONETSK AND LUHANSK OBLASTS AND CRIMEA

The so-called DPR and LPR have restricted access to the Viber messenger. The self-proclaimed LPR said that this is "a response to the repeated increasing use of the service as part of the enemy's military infrastructure in order to obtain geolocation data and find critical military-civilian infrastructure." In the so-called DPR note that the decision was made allegedly to avoid the spread of unreliable information of a civil and military nature, direct threats to recipients from unidentified senders, propaganda of violence, informational and psychological pressure, etc.

Representatives of the so-called "people's militia of the DPR" through a video message published on social networks, appealed to the President of the Russian Federation with a request to deal with the situation that has developed with the stay of the 1st company of the 5th rifle battalion of the 113th regiment at the forefront in the Kherson oblast for 3 months. According to the organizer of the appeal, their company did not have proper material, medical and food support; the mobilization procedure was carried out without a medical examination, which is why people with chronic diseases, including mental ones, guardians, fathers of many children were called up. As follows from the appeal, the higher headquarters ignores all the stated problems. It was also indicated that, according to the statement of the Head of the so-called DPR, units of the mobilization reserve are not involved in the front line, but in practice this is not true.

The Defence Intelligence of the Ministry of Defence of Ukraine intercepted a conversation between a man and a woman living in the so-called DPR, discussing how in temporarily occupied territories of Donetsk and Luhansk regions they are "promoting" signing of contracts with the Armed Forces of the Russian Federation. According to the woman, those who disagree to sign the contract are put in the basement to become more pliable. She knows about seven men who, after being tortured, agreed to join the ranks of the RF Armed Forces. They were promised to pay 230 thousand rubles a month. According to her information, on the same day they were sent to the front lines. As a result, one was killed and four were injured.

On the territory of the so-called DPR and LPR began to operate the Russian bank Promsvyazbank, which is under international sanctions. This is the first Russian financial institution in the self-proclaimed republics.

The wives of the mobilized military from the so-called DPR recorded a video message in which they said that for about four months they did not know about the whereabouts of their husbands, who on February 24, as part of the mobilization campaign, were included in the personnel of the military unit 08801 of the city of Komsomolske, Donetsk oblast (now Kalmiusske), and in currently serving in the 2nd battalion of the 121st regiment. According to the women, on June 6, the mobilized were supposed to be returned to the unit, but only one company returned to the place of permanent deployment; the whereabouts of the remaining two hundred people is unknown. Appeals of relatives of the military to all possible instances remained without results.

According to the women, for all four months the soldiers did not have any dismissal or corresponding payments. In addition, during the mobilization there was no medical examination, which is why people with disabilities were also drafted into the military.

■ In Simferopol, an unknown person tried to set fire to the military enlistment office on Selvinsky Street. He threw a bottle of combustible mixture through the window, but it shattered on the bars. Investigators are studying video footage to find the perpetrator and bring him to justice.

She was found guilty of desecrating a grave for reasons of political hostility.



Valeriia Holdenberh was born in Poltava and has lived in the Crimea for the last 17 years. According to her, she did her act "out of a sense of revenge and compassion for the people of Ukraine."

In the Kherson oblast, the Russian military, threatening with weapons, demanded that the owner of the agricultural enterprise give the keys to the combine-harvester "for the needs of the army." The farmers responded with a categorical refusal. With further escalation of the conversation, the security of the enterprise opened fire, as a result of which two soldiers were killed, the rest fled.
