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# ATROCITIES OF THE RUSSIAN ARMY

#### IN THE OCCUPIED TERRITORIES

As a result of the exchange, five civilians were released from Russian captivity, four of whom were detained during the occupation of the Kyiv oblast. The men spent 109 days in captivity. All of them were subjected to physical and psychological torture by Russian soldiers. It was necessary to greet the prison guards with a pioneer salute. They were forced to read and retell Soviet books, learn and sing the anthem of the Russian Federation, as well as a whole range of Russian songs, including "We are Russians, God is with us!", "Uncle Vova, we are with you", songs by Gazmanov. Sometimes prisoners had to sing for up to six hours straight. If someone sang badly, he was beaten or forced to squat 150 times.

The Russian invaders dismantled and removed the largest solar power plant in Ukraine, Tokmak Solar Energy, which is located near the city of Tokmak, Zaporizhzhya oblast.

According to the townspeople, solar panels were dismantled, packed and taken out for a long time. The area of the station reaches 96 hectares, its capacity is 50 MW. Solar plant was able to supply electricity to six districts of the Zaporizhzhya oblast.

According to The Wall Street Journal, at the captured Zaporizhzhya Nuclear Power Plant in Enerhodar, Russian invaders are looking for Ukrainian spies among the workers of the nuclear facility. Among the 11,000 personnel there are more than 500 Russian servicemen who patrol the station with weapons, reproach workers who speak Ukrainian, not Russian, and check their mobile phones for loyalty to the Ukrainian authorities. Some handcuffed employees were sent for interrogation. Many returned with injuries, more than ten workers were missing. According to the Mayor of Enerhodar, Dmytro Orlov, the hostages are tortured with electric shocks, beaten, and imprisoned for weeks, and sometimes even months. They demand to confess to "illegal activities" - concealment of weapons, participation in self-defense of the city, to name the names of their "accomplices".

Also, according to him, the Russians loot, rob people, take out the property of territorial communities.

In the village of Zaporizhzhya near Tokmak, Ukrainians who tore the Russian flag from the building of a village school were forced to put it back under escort of armed Russian soldiers. One of the men, under pressure, says "Glory to Russia."

The BBC published an article describing torture and humiliation during the passage of filtration by Ukrainians who were leaving the occupied Mariupol. The Russian military checks phones, reviews personal records on social networks, and asks provocative questions. Anything in doubt can lead to beatings, interrogations with electric shocks. The detainees, including women, are kept in cells without water and food, they are forced to relieve their natural needs in a corner in front of everyone. During filtration, special attention is paid to men of fighting age. They are checked for bruises, which may indicate a recent use of a weapon.

According to Ukrainian human rights activists, torture during the filtration process is not just a separate case or an act of violence by one soldier, but a purposeful policy of the Russian Federation, planned in advance and well prepared.

On June 27, 2022, representatives of the so-called Kherson Military-Civilian Administration, with the support of representatives of the FSS of the Russian Federation and the participation of the head of the service of air and cable electrical networks of Khersonoblenergo JSK, separate facilities belonging to the enterprise and ensuring the supply and distribution of electrical energy to consumers in the Kherson oblast were seized. During the capture of Khersonoblenergo by the invaders, the so-called new head of the enterprise Yury Zhakhanovich. The occupying authorities put pressure on the employees of the enterprise, forcing them to write applications for cooperation.

In Starobilsk, Luhansk oblast, the occupying authorities are conducting an "inventory" of the equipment of local agricultural companies. They explain that the ultimate goal of these actions is the creation of a "new agricultural enterprise based on the principle of collective farming." Former employees are told that if they return to work, their salary will not exceed RUR 10,000. Those who agree to such conditions must return to work in June and take Russian citizenship by September.

Kherson farmers continue to throw away the grown crop due to the impossibility of selling it. According to them, no one buys vegetables, in particular cabbage, in Crimea because of the loss of its presentation due to the long (up to 3 days) idle time of farmers at the border. The occupiers forbid selling crops in the territories controlled by the Ukrainian authorities.

# ABDUCTIONS OF CIVILIANS

According to the Defence Intelligence of the Ministry of Defence of Ukraine (hereinafter - GUR MoD), in the temporarily occupied territories of Zaporizhzhya, Kherson and Mykolaiv oblasts, cases of kidnapping of relatives of the Ukrainian military are becoming systemic. At the same time, both adults, including women and the elderly, and children are kidnapped. Subsequently, the Russians can contact the Ukrainian military and demand to arrive in the occupied territories in exchange for the safety of their relatives.

■ The Mayor of Enerhodar, Dmytro Orlov, reports that in the occupied city, Russians are kidnapping and torturing people for ransom. The standard price for the release of one hostage is UAH 50,000, which is extorted from the prisoner themself or their relatives.

In Nova Kakhovka, a teacher, director of vocational school No. 14, Ihor Serdyuk, was kidnapped from his workplace. From the very beginning of the war, the man provided assistance to low-income sections of the population. He negotiated with local businesses to supply food to the school, where cooks prepared food and fed the needy residents of Nova Kakhovka for free.

In Kherson, the invaders kidnapped the Mayor Ihor Kolykhaiev, who had previously refused to cooperate with the occupation administration and remained in the city.

The so-called "Deputy head of the Military-Civilian Administration of the Kherson oblast" Kyrylo Stremousov confirmed that Kolykhaiev had been detained. According to him, Kolykhaiev "sabotaged the work", "called for the processes to be ignored" and "harmed the process of denazification."

On June 28, Oleksandr Babych, the Mayor of Hola Prystan city, and Ivan Samoilenko, the village Mayor of Stanislav, from the Kherson oblast, were released from Russian captivity. Babych spent three months in captivity - on March 28 he was kidnapped because of his patriotic position and refusal to cooperate with the invaders. Ivan Samoilenko was taken prisoner on June 24 when heading, together with communal workers, to an emergency site to repair the electrical network.

■ While the majority of Mariupol residents do not have access to either drinking or technical water, and the time spent in a public shower is limited to 10 minutes, in order to demonstrate a "prosperous life" in the city, the occupation authorities organized watering the streets using special equipment, during which each time several hundred cubic meters of water are consumed.

In the humanitarian headquarters in the building of the former shopping center Metro the "volunteers" who were engaged in clearing rubble and landscaping work were paid the wages. Instead of the announced salary for a month and a half, employees were given RUR 11,000 for one month only. A riot began among the people, because of which the invaders were forced to close the humanitarian headquarters, the Russian military dispersed the protesters with shots in the air.





The occupying authorities begin the demolition of the destroyed buildings. Notifications are posted on houses whose residents are being prepared for eviction, assigning them to prepare for relocation to a "maneuverable housing stock", remove all belongings and leave the building themselves. At some locations, the residents of the house were given only one day to remove their personal belongings, which is why they staged a protest on the day of the demolition, preventing the work of the equipment of the EMERCOM of Russia. As a result of the protest action, the occupation administration of the city decided that the demolition of houses would take place no less than two weeks after the first notification of residents.

- According to the adviser of the Mariupol Mayor Petro Andriushchenko, the occupation authorities of the city took a decision on the actual procedure for the demolition and repair of damaged houses:
  - people will be resettled to the unoccupied undamaged apartments;
  - apartments in which the owners do not appear within three months will be recognized as ownerless and will become the property of the city;
  - if owners of apartments where people already live appear, then it will be the owners who will be resettled in other free housing;
  - organization of storage of personal belongings and furniture is not provided. Given the absence of any warehouses other than military ones, people will be forced to leave furniture either in apartments or on the streets;
  - the beginning of the active demolition phase is planned for the second decade of July.
     On July 1, a general list of houses for demolition will be made public. The timing of the demolition of each house will be set according to the situation, taking into account the actual number of its inhabitants.

#### According to the GUR MoD in Mariupol:

- a population census is being conducted, during which residents are required to provide identification documents, as well as undergo a fingerprinting procedure;
- several film crews of Russian TV channels are working, with the task of demonstrating the "establishment of peaceful life";
- private funeral teams from the Russian Federation began to work. The price of their "services" is UAH 10,000 for the burial of one body.

- The Mayor of Enerhodar, Zaporizhzhya oblast, Dmytro Orlov, describes the current situation in the city:
  - accepting of documents for registration of citizenship of the Russian Federation has started;
  - it was announced that Ukrainian mobile operators, as well as ATMs accepting noncash payments in hryvnia, will be completely disabled in the near future. Among the residents of the city, a rush began to withdraw cash from bank cards despite considerable fee;
  - the beginning of work of the Crimean Internet provider was announced;
  - the issuance of the so-called "finacial one-time aid" equivalent RUR 10,000 to pensioners, which was paid in exchange for the recipients providing their passport data, was stopped.

According to the "official" letter from the administration of the central city hospital of the occupied Pervomaisk, Luhansk oblast, to the so-called "Minister of Health of the LPR", from May 15 to June 15, 893 servicemen from Russia and the so-called LPR were hospitalized in a medical facility, of which 124 died due to their injuries.

The personnel of the 4th Infantry Battalion of the 109th Infantry Regiment, formed from residents of the so-called DPR appealed to the President of the Russian Federation and the "head of the DPR" with a request to provide clarifications and address a number of issues related to the service.

According to them:

- persons who were not fit for military service for health reasons, as well as students who were full-time students were illegally drafted;
- the unit is formed from soldiers who have not undergone mandatory military training. The battalion is not staffed by commanders and officers with combat experience and understanding of what is happening on the battlefield;
- none of the drafted persons was familiar with the orders for their enrollment in the battalion. After 4 months, there are no documents on their military service;
- for 120 days of mobilization, no one has ever been on legal leave, neither soldiers nor members of their families receive monetary allowances;
- being on the first line of defense, in the zone of active combat operations, military personnel do not have means of protection bulletproof vests and helmets. In May, old bulletproof vests were provided, partly without armor plates, with visible mechanical damage, the use of which is prohibited by the instructions on the bulletproof vest itself. There are no means of communication and night vision device;
- medical care is not provided, there is no option for treating people with chronic diseases;
- senior officers completely ignore existing problems;
- with the increasing shelling and air raids of the Armed Forces of Ukraine, without the support of the Russian army, the personnel are demoralized, morale is broken;
- soldiers of the 4th Rifle Battalion of the 109th Rifle Regiment demand rotation from the combat zone, return to the point of permanent deployment, and the direction of personnel to the 3rd line of defense to guard strategic facilities on the territory of the so-called DPR, providing the obligatory leave for the entire period of service.


