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# ANNEXATION OF UKRAINIAN TERRITORIES

- On October 3 and 4, the Russian State Duma and Federation Council voted unanimously to ratify “treaties” on the inclusion of the so-called DPR and LPR, as well as Zaporizhzhia and Kherson oblasts of Ukraine, into Russia.

The laws adopted by the State Duma on the inclusion of the new regions state that the borders of Zaporizhzhia and Kherson oblasts are determined by the borders “existing on the day of their incorporation into the Russian Federation,” while the borders of the so-called DPR and LPR are determined by the borders “established on the day of their formation and on the day of their incorporation into the Russian Federation.”

Until January 1, 2026, there will be a transition period for the annexed regions to “integrate into the military, economic, financial, credit and legal systems of the Russian Federation and into the system of state authorities of the Russian Federation.” The official language in the illegally annexed regions is Russian; the monetary unit is the rouble, with the Ukrainian hryvnia allowed to circulate until December 31, 2022.

On October 4, the formal process of annexation of the four partially occupied Ukrainian oblasts ended with the Russian president’s signing of “constitutional laws” to incorporate them into Russia. Based on these laws, the first part of Article 65 of the Russian Constitution, which lists Russian regions, was amended to include Kherson and Zaporizhzhia oblasts, as well as the so-called DPR and LPR as new subjects of the Russian Federation.

## ELEMENT OF TERROR FROM THE SIDE OF THE RUSSIAN ARMY AND OCCUPATION ADMINISTRATIONS

- On October 1, a convoy of seven civilian cars was found shelled between the villages of Kurylivka and Pishchane, in the Kupiansk district, Kharkiv oblast.

According to investigators, on September 25, a local carrier organized the evacuation of civilians from the occupied territory.

On the way, the convoy was fired at by a Russian sabotage and reconnaissance group; they used a machine gun mounted on an APC to attack vehicles. The Russians set fire to the remains of the cars to cover up the crime.

As a result of the terrorist attack, 24 people were killed, including 13 children and one pregnant woman.

On October 12, during an additional inspection, law enforcers found the 25th victim of the attack, a 75-year-old woman who, according to preliminary reports, had crawled about



200 metres in the direction of Kupiansk-Vuzlovyi urban-type settlement and died in a landing after attacking the convoy of vehicles. The body of the deceased was sent for forensic examination.

■ **Another torture chamber has been discovered in the village of Pisky-Radkivski, Kharkiv oblast, which was liberated during a counterattack by Ukrainian troops.**

Local residents told the police that in the basement of one of the houses prisoners were kept and tortured: civilians, former ATO members and prisoners of the Armed Forces of Ukraine. In the dungeon, the police found a dildo, a box of torn-out dentures, wires, ropes, and a sheet of paper with the testimony of one of the prisoners.

The police already know for sure about torture – burying alive in the ground and using a gas mask with a smouldering rag.

A local resident who was in captivity told the police about the circumstances of getting into the basement and the beatings inflicted on him. According to the man, he was sitting with a guy who was shot in the legs for shouting “Glory to Ukraine.”

A 67-year-old man, accused by the Russians of adjusting fire, had his arm broken during interrogation and then had bicycle spokes stuck under the skin around his shoulder blades. They wanted to know who the victim was working for. After numerous beatings, the man lost consciousness. He is currently undergoing treatment in one of the medical institutions of Kharkiv.

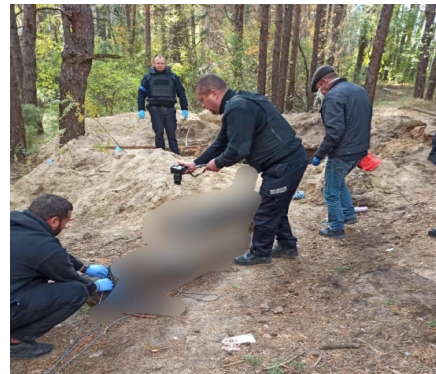


- At the recreation centre in the village of Novoplatonivka, Kharkiv oblast, Ukrainian law enforcement officers found the “headquarters” of Russian military and a torture pit with the bodies of two dead.

The bodies of two men, aged between 30 and 35, were found by the Ukrainian police: their hands were tied together with handcuffs. They had gunshot wounds to the head.

A resident of the Borova community told the police about the “headquarters” and the torture pit. Her grandson Serhii Avdieiev, a former ATO members who was abducted by the Russians on September 9, was tortured in this pit. The woman found Serhii’s body on her own after the military left the base. According to the murdered guy’s father, the body showed many stab wounds and 15 gunshot wounds.

- The torture chamber was discovered in a boarding house not far from the Sviatohirska Lavra.

The Russian military forcefully held local residents there who supported the territorial integrity of Ukraine. During the inspection, operatives, and investigators of the SSU discovered objects that directly indicate signs of torture.

- In the village of Yatskivka near Lyman, law enforcers have uncovered a centre of operations of the occupiers.

The Russians set up their headquarters in one of the private houses. Lists of prisoners and people arrested illegally were found in the building. Among other things, documents with the personal data and candidate applications for positions of individuals who decided to work in the occupier-captured enterprises and organizations were seized.

- According to the police of the Kherson oblast:

- In Hola Prystan, occupiers are driving local residents to the street and moving into their houses, appropriating all their property.
- In Kherson, the invaders have seized a number of public institutions and private companies: the premises of the state executive service department, the territory of an enterprise for the wholesale trade in wood and building materials, the premises and property of an audit firm, the territory of a plant for the production of engines, and the territory of the enterprise for the production of dry building mixtures.
- In the Novotroitsk community, the military of the Russian Federation seized the premises of a bank branch.
- In the Beryslav and Kakhovka districts, the Russian military plundered two agricultural enterprises, taking away tractors, navigation systems for sowing, combines, reapers, and cars.
- In one pharmacy in Kherson, the occupiers conducted an illegal search and seized documents, boxes of medicines, computer equipment, cash proceeds and keys to the premises.

- The principal conductor of Kherson's Mykola Kulish Music and Drama Theatre, Yuriy Kerpatenko, was shot dead in his home after months of refusing to cooperate with the occupying authorities.

- According to the General Staff of the Armed Forces of Ukraine, in Melitopol district, Zaporizhzhia oblast, the occupation troops have been conducting searches and stealing private cars from garage cooperatives under the form of searching for and fighting against guerrillas.

- On October 5, the Russian president signed a decree establishing the facilities of the Zaporizhzhia nuclear power plant as the property of the Russian Federation.

The decree says that the joint-stock company *Operating Organization of the Zaporizhzhia NPP* will now operate the plant "by its own efforts or with the involvement of other organizations."

According to BBC News, Ukrainian staff at the Zaporizhzhia NPP, which has been under Russian occupation for more than seven months, have been receiving threats that they may be forced to fight on the Russian side unless they sign documents to go to work for Rosatom. One BBC News interlocutor says Rosatom wants to keep Ukrainian staff at the plant because it could take up to 8-10 years to train new employees.

## ABDUCTIONS OF CIVILIANS

- On 1 October, the Russians kidnapped Ihor Murashov, the Director General of the Zaporizhzhia NPP.

According to Petro Kotin, President of Energoatom, Murashov was detained by a Russian patrol on his way from the ZNPP to Enerhodar [ZNPP's satellite city]. His car was stopped, he was forcibly detained, blindfolded and taken in an unknown direction. The International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA) has asked the Russian authorities for an explanation regarding the detention of Ihor Murashov, Director General of the Zaporizhzhia Nuclear Power Plant (ZNPP).

# FILTRATION MEASURES AND DEPORTATION OF UKRAINIAN CITIZENS

- According to the Head of the Luhansk Regional Military Administration, Serhii Haidai, 76 orphans were taken to Russian social rehabilitation centres for minors located in Moscow region. Four regions of Russia have to accept them as part of family groups. 104 more children who now stay in social institutions of the so-called LPR will soon be transferred to Russian families.

- Thanks to the Reckoning Project, the story of Matvii, a 12-year-old boy from Mariupol, who was taken with his younger sisters from their home to the Moscow region, has come to light. Their father Yevhen, who is raising children alone, was taken to the Olenivka prison camp during filtration measures because Russians saw the registration in his passport from a military unit in western Ukraine. He had served there as a mechanic from 2016 to 2019 under contract. In total, Yevhen spent 45 days in the prison camp, being interrogated and beaten. Matvii managed to find his father, and they kept in touch by telephone after his release. After the children's stay in the camp near Moscow ended, they were to be returned to Donetsk, where their father would pick them up. However, social service officers told Matvii that they would be placed in foster care or shelter in Russia, stressing that it was not safe in Donetsk. Matvii contacted the father and the man managed to come and collect the children, despite financial and bureaucratic difficulties.

The family is currently living in Latvia. According to Matvii, the day after they left the camp, all the Ukrainian children living there were sent to foster families. One of the boys was adopted by Maria Lvova-Belova, Commissioner of the President of the Russian Federation for Children's Rights.

- Filtering procedures continue in Mariupol. A large queue of city residents was recorded at one of the filtering points located in the Central District Police Department. According to the adviser to Mariupol mayor, Petro Andriushchenko, it was in the building of the Central District Police Department that Russians set up a prison. "Suspects" are detained here, and confessions of cooperation with Ukraine are extracted by torture.

# MOBILIZATION

## IN THE OCCUPIED TERRITORIES

- According to the Head of the Luhansk Regional Military Administration, Serhii Haidai, the Russian military leadership is trying to compensate for the significant daily losses of personnel by conscripting people from Ukraine's occupied territories.

The men from Luhansk are sent straight to reinforce the units that suffered the most casualties, without a medical commission or training. At the same time, training centres set up in Luhansk oblast train new recruits from private military campaigns recruited in prisons.

## SITUATION

### IN THE OCCUPIED SETTLEMENTS

- According to the adviser to Mariupol mayor, Petro Andriushchenko, the local authorities reported at a closed meeting in the occupation administration that they have time to finish no more than 30% of the planned repairs of flat buildings before the onset of cold weather. There are no plans to start working on private sector buildings this year.

- On October 12, rocket fire by the Russian army damaged the Dniprovskia substation in Dnipropetrovsk oblast, causing an emergency shutdown of the communication line Zaporizhzhia NPP-Dniprovskia.

The Zaporizhzhia NPP was completely de-energized with the start-up of backup diesel generators. *Energoatom* prepared and sent another batch of diesel fuel to the ZNPP, but the Russian side does not allow the company's convoy of vehicles to pass.

During the day, Ukrainian specialists restored power supply to the ZNPP.

- In the de-occupied settlements of the Kherson oblast, the regional military administration is restoring electricity supply, setting up mobile communications, delivering humanitarian aid and paying pensions. Mobile branches of *Nova Poshta* recovered their work in the villages of Vysokopillia, Velyka Oleksandrivka and Arkhanhelske.

- *Ukrposhta* resumed work in de-occupied Lyman and Sviatohirsk, Donetsk oblast, where residents can receive their pensions and humanitarian aid.
- The first ATM of *Oschadbank* started working in Sviatohirsk. Measures to restore electricity, mobile communications and the Internet are continuing, and the evacuation of local residents is underway during the autumn-winter period.
- The exhumation and reburial of those who died during the occupation takes place in the liberated cities. Two mass burial sites were found in Lyman. According to local residents, civilians are buried in one place and military personnel — in another. Some 150 graves have been discovered in the civilian burial plot. Many of the dead have mine blast injuries, and there are bodies with signs of torture.
- In Sviatohirsk, the bodies of 21 people who died during shelling and buried in yards and vegetable gardens were reburied.

- Due to the shelling of Enerhodar, the city's electricity and water supply was cut off for several days. People were forced to cook food on a campfire. The situation with drinking water in the city is getting worse. According to Dmytro Orlov, the Mayor of Enerhodar, the occupiers are not letting in any deliveries of humanitarian aid, food, hygiene products, or even drinking water.

- The so-called State Defence Committee of the DPR issued a “decree” according to which dormitories of the Pryazovskyi State Technical University, National University “Odesa Maritime Academy,” Mariupol State University and others are transferred from state ownership to municipal ownership, which means their de facto nationalization.

Some private hotels and buildings should also be forcibly seized and returned to municipal ownership, with compensation being paid to the owners for the cost of the properties.

- From January 1, 2023, in the illegally annexed territories of Luhansk oblast, all social payments will be made only with an individual personal account, which can only be obtained with a Russian passport.

- The counterattack by the Ukrainian army in Kherson oblast forced the so-called “head” of the region, Volodymyr Saldo, to ask the Russian leadership to help to set up a way for Kherson families to travel to “other parts of the Russian Federation” (Crimea, Rostov Oblast, Stavropol, and Krasnodar Krai) for holidays and studies. Kyrlo Stremousov, who is the deputy head of the military administration, insists that these measures are “concern for the residents of Russia living in the territory of the Kherson oblast,” and there is no evacuation. According to him, no one from the leadership is leaving Kherson or is not going to surrender the region to the Ukrainian army, and the organization of the departure is meant to protect people from the risks of shelling.

In response to Saldo's appeal, Russian Deputy Prime Minister Marat Khusnullin guaranteed assistance to the “administration” of Kherson oblast in accommodating its residents in “other” subjects of the Russian Federation.

Дорогие ребята!

Произошло очень важное для всех нас историческое событие. На прошлой неделе мы - жители Донецкой, Луганской народных республик, Херсона и Запорожья (наши родители, дедушки и бабушки) приняли участие в референдуме и сделали свой выбор. Мы все практически единогласно решили, что наше будущее в России, что мы хотим быть российскими гражданами.

30 сентября 2022 года в Москве в Большом Кремлевском дворце состоялась церемония подписания договоров о присоединении к России ДНР, ЛНР, Херсонской и Запорожской областей.

Наше прошлое неразрывно связано с Россией, те земли, на которых мы живем, всегда были российскими. Города Херсон и Запорожье были основаны Екатериной II в 1778 году как центры кораблестроения России. Несколько десятилетиями позже образовались города Луганск и Донецк, ставшие крупными промышленными российскими центрами. Все время наши регионы входили в состав российского государства, и только лишь последние 30 лет существовали отдельно.

Давайте вспомним/разберем, что представляет собой референдум. Референдум является формой непосредственного волеизъявления граждан, проводится в форме голосования по какому-либо важному вопросу. Референдум считается состоявшимся, если проголосовало более 50% населения.

Несмотря на желание киевского режима помешать волеизъявлению наших граждан, референдумы состоялись.

Мы, более 6 млн. жителей Донбасса, Запорожья и Херсонской области, сделали свой выбор - практически единогласно проголосовали за вхождение в состав Российской Федерации.

Западное сообщество не раз признавало решения о присоединении территорий к другим государствам – мировая история содержит сразу

несколько таких примеров. Часто такие решения принимались против воли государств, в состав которых входили эти территории. И в значительной части подобных случаев результаты были признаны западными странами, а в некоторых – сами процедуры инициировались и активно поддерживались Западом.

В 1991 году референдумы о независимости были проведены в некоторых республиках СССР (Эстонской, Украинской, Грузинской, Молдавской, Туркменской, Армянской и Азербайджанской). Все референдумы были проведены вопреки руководству Советского Союза, тем не менее они были признаны международным сообществом.

Самым резонансным примером в новейшей истории стал «косовский прецедент». Решение о выходе автономного края Косово из состава Югославии было принято вопреки воле югославского государства. Сербия по сей день не признает факт выхода Косова. Тем не менее, это не помешало странам Запада признать независимость Косова.

Сейчас же мы видим, что США и страны ЕС считают незаконными результаты прошедших референдумов и вхождение наших территорий в состав Российской Федерации, что говорит о проявлении политики двойных стандартов.

Присоединение наших территорий к России гарантирует нам безопасность, единые права и обязанности наравне с российскими гражданами.

Наш выбор смелый и правильный. Начался новый этап нашей жизни в составе большой и сильной России.

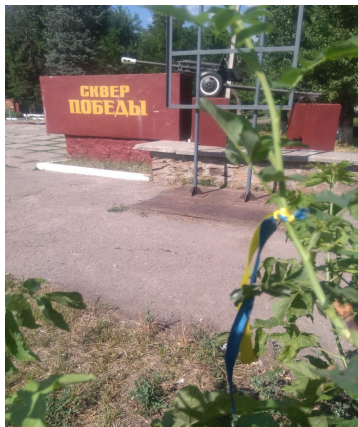
## IN CERTAIN AREAS OF DONETSK, LUHANSK OBLASTS AND CRIMEA

- According to the Ukrainian Main Directorate of Intelligence:

A “mobilization campaign” is gaining momentum in occupied Sevastopol. Representatives of military commissars pay the most attention to drivers and tractor drivers. So, in the 1st city hospital, full ambulance drivers received summonses. Also, all tractor drivers of the Zolota Balka winery were taken into the army.

The mobilized are placed in the military camp of the 810th Marine Brigade. Over the last week, about 300 new recruits have arrived here. Most of the staff are men over 40. Among them are participants of the Russian wars in Ichkeria, and several “Afghans.” A significant part of the recruits are former UAF soldiers, who remained in the Crimea after its occupation. Part of the staff has already left for the Donetsk and Kherson directions.

Before being sent to the combat zone, special classes on “political training” are held with the mobilized, at which the following theses are conveyed:

- the Ukrainian leadership has long received and distributed funds for the surrender of territories;
- no one will participate in real hostilities; you just need to shoot for a look;
- the explosions in Crimea were agreed with Putin, so everything is under control;
- we haven’t started anything yet;
- China will soon provide modern missiles to completely destroy Ukrainian cities, the Russian Federation is protecting its missiles for the time.

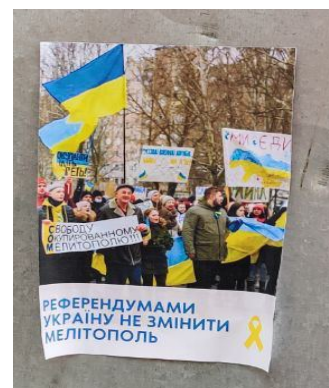
